Located 12 miles east of the city of Los Angeles, the new 2-level, \$60M, 350,000sf El Monte Station doubles the size of the 35-year-old El Monte Transit Center. The project is the anchor of a \$500M transit-oriented development the city plans to build around the new multi-modal transit center. Known as the El Monte Transit Village, the development is expected to bring nearly 2,000 new homes and stores to the area adjacent to the bus station, located on Santa Anita Avenue off the Interstate-10 Freeway.



With approximately 26,000 passengers passing daily through the existing center, it is the busiest bus station west of Chicago, according to the owner, the Los Angeles Metropolitan Transit Authority.

Upon its opening in 2012, it provided transit service on numerous lines for Metro, Foothill Transit, LAX FlyAway airport shuttle and Greyhound and with 28 bus-bays, it is the largest bus-only transit center west of the Mississippi. MCH provided full-scope acoustical consulting to ensure traveler comfort and appropriate intelligibility of public announcements for passengers .
