The Exposition Line will be the first modern transit project to serve the western part of the Los Angeles area. Transit service from downtown Los Angeles to the Culver City Station began in April 2012. The complete line through to the famous Santa Monica Pier is expected to be operational by 2015, with an overall budget of \$2.4B.

The \$90M Vehicle Maintenance Facility will be located adjacent to the Bergamot Transit Station and Art Gallery Complex. It will perform shop-related activities, including servicing, cleaning, inspection, and repair of light rapid transit (LRT) vehicles. It will also include a yard with a storage capacity of up to 45 LRT vehicles.

MCH is providing acoustical planning and design for this community-sensitive element, to ensure that any associated environmental noise and vibration impacts are fully mitigated. The area includes an immediately-adjacent residential neighborhood and several recording studios.
