The five-story Chandler City Hall opened in November 2010 as a 131,700-square-foot, \$47M facility to replace the leased office space employees have been working in for over 10 years. The project achieved LEED Gold certification. The complex includes an administrative office tower, an exhibition gallery, City Council chambers and adjacent structures that house the city's cable TV broadcast, production and recording studio with requisite control rooms, editing bays and voiceover room.

The new Council Chambers is an iconic element on the campus plaza, clad in glass and glowing at night. City staff are housed in the office tower, including the Mayor and Council, City Manager, Human Resources, Communications & Public Affairs (CAPA), Management Services, Community Services, Economic Development, Downtown Real Estate and City Attorney.

MCH provided full-scope acoustical and AV services including those associated with the cable TV facilities.
