St. John Vianney Church is home to a dynamic Catholic community with over 5,300 families. The new Church opened with Dedication Mass on June 23, 2018, seven years after the previous Church had been lost to arson.

MCH provided full-service acoustical & media systems consulting, from design through final tuning.

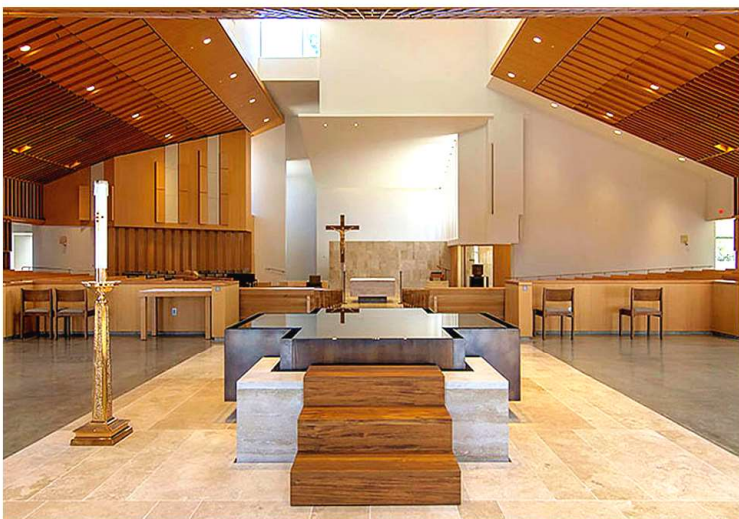
The ceremonial doors and baptismal font are within the footprint of the original Church, and the main outline of the original church is an outdoor Gathering Space. The Church offers seating for 1,200 parishioners, 6 shrines, and Blessed Sacrament Chapel.

All spaces are fully isolated from the noisy, adjacent Pomona Highway, and the HVAC system is inaudible in the worship spaces.

The vigorous music community includes a 40-person choir, praise band, guitar groups, and liturgical music, with an organ with moveable console and a grand piano.

There are two separate but complimentary sound systems; one primarily for spoken word, and the other primarily for music reinforcement.
