



This 40,000 SF innovative auditorium opened in 2008 (construction cost undisclosed) on Midwestern University's rapidly growing campus in Glendale, AZ. The auditorium deploys movable partitions of a rather sophisticated design to create up to 6 various sized lecture rooms that can function concurrently. With the presentation stage at its core, the partitions can be retracted to create one large space seating 2,600 accommodating major campus events, presentations and graduation ceremonies as well as community-hosted functions.

The ceiling design was carefully engineered to permit easy, unamplified Q&A among audience/students for all but the very largest space arrangement. MCH provided full scope Acoustical and Audiovisual Services for this remarkable state-of-the-art venue.
