This 10-acre parcel has hosted some of Hollywood's biggest stars since the Golden Age of film. Charlie Chaplin, Douglas Fairbanks, and Mary Pickford have practiced their craft on these grounds. Included in its credits are the likes of *Hopalong Cassidy*, *Life of Riley*, *Stanley Kramer Productions*, *Adventures of Superman*, *Gunsmoke*, *Have Gun Will Travel*, *Space Patrol*, *Perry Mason* and Ronald Reagan's *Death Valley Days*.

Since 1979, Raleigh Studios has regularly tapped MCH staff to help it become one of the most state-of-the-art studios in Hollywood. Included were the connected Sound Stages 11&12 and 14, the Jordan Building repurposing for Post-Production (3 Editing Suites, 3 Screening Rooms and a Foley Stage) as well as the East Office Building.
