Originally opened in 1959, this not-for-profit entity evolved from its predecessors, the Phoenix Art Center and the Phoenix Fine Arts Association. In 1965, the Museum building expanded to 75,000sf and in 1996 celebrated the major renovation and expansion for which MCH provided full-scope acoustical and AV consulting, to over 160,000sf. This work, by architects Tod Williams Billie Tsien made it one of the largest general visual arts institutions in the Southwest. In addition to the new, mediated presentation auditorium, the overall project included a renovation of the museum's neighbor, the Phoenix Little Theater.

The Phoenix Art Museum is alive with activity and offers something for everyone in the family. It hosts well over 200,000 visitors each year and reaches an additional 40,000 through its outreach programs.
