In 1998, a sixteen-acre site was chosen for this project along the east side of the Rio Grande at Fourth Street and Avenida César Chávez in an area known as the Barelas neighborhood. The \$12.5M, 58,100sf Phase I of the National Hispanic Cultural Center (NHCC) was substantially completed by the inaugural opening in late October of 2000.

Phase 1 includes the Research and Literary Arts building and the Intel Technology and Visual Arts Complex. The Research and Literary Arts Center consists of a research library, a special collections area, an oral history listening room, a ballroom, and an indoor/outdoor restaurant. The Visual Arts Complex is home to 11,000sf of gallery space, technology classroom, gift shop, broadcast studio, and the majority of the Center's administrative offices. Adjacent to the Visual Arts Complex is a 100-seat lecture hall for visiting artists and scholars. The Plaza Mayor, Plaza de los Milagros, Torreon, and other landscaping features are included in this phase.
